

# Summer courses 2025

Spanish in Summer

May, June, July & August



## Course description

Our intensive summer courses combine Spanish language learning with other subjects that students can choose based on their needs and levels, all within a center with extensive experience.

## Contents

### Language

These classes focus on developing Spanish language competence through a communicative-functional approach. Through interactive activities, students learn grammar, vocabulary, and pronunciation, while developing skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing, gaining confidence and fluency in the language.

The course is adapted to different levels, from beginners to advanced. Daily activities and dynamics inside and outside the classroom place students in real learning situations and contexts.

### Culture

These sessions delve into Spanish cultural identity through basic aspects of geography, politics, and recent history, as well as customs, leisure, family and social life, character, and values.

Intercultural understanding is promoted to enable students to interact with respect and empathy in a diverse world, helping them gain not only language skills but also a broad vision of the cultural diversity within the Spanish-speaking world.

### Spanish for Business

In this course, students acquire the vocabulary and linguistic resources needed to operate in the professional world. Topics range from writing a résumé or attending a job interview to the business activities of a company (types of companies, internal structure, trade fairs, etc.).

These contents are developed through presentations, practical exercises (individual and group), and authentic materials taken from textbooks and media sources. Current news related to the subject is also discussed.



## Spanish for Healthcare

This course includes activities, tasks, and real-life situations with a communicative and task-based approach. Special emphasis is placed on learning specific medical terminology.

Classes are dynamic, with a variety of communicative activities so that students can practice all skills and use the necessary lexical, grammatical, and functional resources to communicate effectively. For example, students may work on a practical case study with a faculty member from the University of Valladolid's School of Medicine.



## Literature

This class is designed for international students interested in exploring Spain's rich literary tradition. It covers the historical context, literary movements, and major cultural influences that have shaped Spanish literature.

Through discussions, essays, and creative activities, students not only improve their language skills but also gain a deeper appreciation of Spanish culture and identity.

## Duration

You can enroll for two, three, four, or five weeks, with the option of taking a longer course, just ask us.

Our summer courses are 20 hours per week.

## Schedule

Classes and workshops take place in the mornings, leaving afternoons free for cultural activities in the city center.



## Levels

A1, A2, B1, B2, and C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

A minimum required level is necessary to take the Health, Business, and Literature subjects.

Students must take an online placement test at least fifteen days before the start of the course.
