SPANISH IN SPRING

from September to December 2025



Course description

The Fall Course at the Centro de Idiomas of the University of Valladolid offers Spanish Language and Culture classes, focusing on speaking skills, language use, and vocabulary. The course includes cultural activities and trips that take your learning experience beyond the classroom, making it an enriching and fulfilling adventure.

Content

Language lessons are designed for students eager to learn Spanish and improve their communication skills. Through interactive activities, students learn grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation, while developing their oral and written skills, gaining confidence and fluency in the language. The course covers different levels, from beginner to advanced. Authentic materials are generally used to foster intercultural understanding. This enables students to interact with the others both respectfully and empathetically in a diverse world, where both language skills and insight into the cultural diversity of the Hispanic world are vital.

In these lessons, Spanish history, art, music, gastronomy and traditions are explored. Students gain deep knowledge and appreciation of its cultural diversity. This comprehensive approach allows them not only to learn about historical and contemporary aspects but also to experience Spanish traditions and lifestyle.



Duration

This course lasts **11 weeks**, with a total of **165 hours**, from **September to mid-December**.

Our schedule runs from approximately 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM, allowing you to enjoy your afternoons and evenings for cultural and leisure activities.

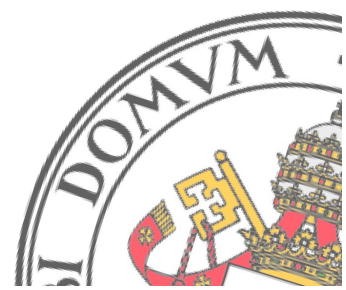
Levels

A1, A2, B1, B2, and C1, according to the Common European Framework of References for Languages (CEFR).

You should take an online placement test, at least, fifteen days before the start your course.
